Required Registration Documents

- Proof of Residency-current utility bills only (water or electric)
- Parent/Guardian state issued ID (must be parent or legal guardian)
- Birth certificate
- Social security card
- Shot records
- PK only: Current pay stub or last year's federal tax return (2019)
- PK only: SNAP EDG (Eligibility Determination Group) number (if you have one)

Before completing the registration for your child, please read through the important information included below.

How does my child qualify for Pre-Kindergarten?

To be eligible for enrollment in a free prekindergarten class, a child must be four years of age on or before September 1 of the current school year and meet at least one of the following eligibility requirements:

- is unable to speak and comprehend the English language; or
- is educationally disadvantaged (which means a student eligible to participate in the national free or reduced-price lunch program... guidelines can be found [here](#)); or
- is homeless, as defined by 42 U.S.C. Section 1143a, regardless of the residence of the child, of either parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or other person having lawful control of the child; or
- is the child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority; or
- is the child of a member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty; or
- is or ever has been in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services (foster care) following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code; or
- is the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as: a peace officer under Section 3106.002, Government Code; a firefighter under Section 3106.003, Government Code; or an emergency medical first responder under Section 3106.004, Government Code.

Does Lone Oak ISD allow students to pay tuition to attend Pre-Kindergarten?

- Yes. Tuition is \$1,500 per semester and is required in full on or before the first day of the semester.
- It is important to note that there is a limited availability of tuition positions. Students will be notified 2 weeks after the start date of school if there is an available position. Students will be selected in the order in which their registration was completed correctly and in full.
