Dear Buffalo Family,

Lone Oak ISD Nutrition Department will provide FREE meals to **all enrolled students** and **children in the community 18 years and younger**. The School Food Authority has made this local decision to implement the USDA Nationwide Waiver to allow Lone Oak to operate under the Seamless Summer Option Operations.

Meals are available for pick up from 11am to 12pm, Mondays and Wednesdays only.

Curbside FREE Meals are picked up as follows:

Administrative building drive thru

Children/student meals only

A child/student does not need to be present. If child/student is not present, a parent or guardian must be picking up the meals. Adults may not pick up meals for other children/students. Students may not pick up meals for other students. When picking up meals you must show proof of guardianship or birth certificate or a form of student identification from the school.

Mondays sack meals include:

Monday- breakfast/lunch

Tuesday- breakfast/lunch

Wednesdays sack meals include:

Wednesday- breakfast/lunch

Thursday-breakfast/lunch

Starting Monday, September 14, all students who get a complete meal, breakfast and/or lunch, can **temporarily eat free!** This **temporary benefit** will only last while USDA has funding for this Nationwide Waiver. USDA hopes to extend this benefit until December 31, 2020.

All previous negative meal account balances must be paid ASAP.

Positive funds on meal accounts will remain on accounts and available for future purchases.

Continue to submit meal applications for free or reduced meals during this time.

It is advisable to continue to apply for meal benefits so your child will receive free or reduced meal benefits after the Nationwide Waiver is no longer in effect.
