Dear Buffalo Family,

All students who get a complete meal, breakfast and/or lunch, can **temporarily eat free!** This **temporary benefit** will only last while USDA has funding for this Nationwide Waiver. USDA hopes to extend this benefit until May 26, 2021.

All previous negative meal account balances must be paid ASAP.

Positive funds on meal accounts will remain on accounts and available for future purchases. The School Food Authority has made this local decision to implement the USDA Nationwide Waiver to allow Lone Oak to operate under the Seamless Summer Option Operations.

Meal applications for free and reduced meals can still be turned in during this time. It is advisable to continue to apply for meal benefits so your child will receive free or reduced meal benefits after the Nationwide Waiver is no longer in effect.

Lone Oak ISD is offering meals, breakfast and lunch, to all **Online Enrolled Students.**

Meals are available for pick up from 11am to 12pm Monday only.

Meals are picked up as follows:

Administrative building drive thru
Student meals only

Student does not need to be present, if student is not present, a parent or guardian must be picking up the meals. Adults may not pick up meals for other students. Students may not pick up meals for other students. When picking up meals you must show proof of enrollment with LOISD or Guardianship of child.

Mondays sack meals include:

Monday- breakfast/lunch
Tuesday- breakfast/lunch
Wednesday- breakfast/lunch
Thursday-breakfast/lunch
