PJC class format

Classes will be held face to face on the PJC campus. See the attached booklist for additional class information.

PJC Start Date

PJC classes will start **Monday, August 30**

Tuition Cost

\$180 per class. Juniors are taking 2 classes for \$360 per semester. Seniors who are taking 2 classes will be \$360. Those taking 3 classes will be \$540. There could be additional fees charged but normally less than \$20.

PJC Tuition Payment

The payment must be paid by **Friday, August 27**. It needs to be paid in full or a payment plan started. The payment must be made through PJC. You can do it on the phone or go by the Greenville campus or pay on-line.

Dual Credit Scholarship Opportunity

PJC must have this update before they can register your students for classes.

- New students have completed admission paperwork (we did this at school the last week of school). Returning students do not have to complete admission paperwork again.
- I have submitted the paperwork that PJC needs from the high school. Student transcript, counselor letter and immunization record.

- The only thing you must do is to **send updated meningitis records to PJC.**
- Note: Do not delay. This will keep your student from being registered and a bill being generated. Class size is limited so we need to get everything done ASAP
