

LONE OAK FFA SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

In the effort to help further the education of local students, the Lone Oak FFA Booster Club is offering scholarships to graduating seniors. The FFA Booster Club Scholarship and Justin Kalisek Memorial Scholarship.

1. The student must be a graduating senior attending Lone Oak School.
2. They must plan to attend a junior/community college, 4-year university or vocational/technical school.
3. The scholarship must be requested by one year from their high school graduation. The \$1000 scholarships will be paid in 2 payments of \$500 each. Note: Amount may vary
4. Student must be an active participant in school and community activities.
5. Preference will be given to FFA members or students who have taken Agriculture classes while in high school.
6. Please provide a copy of your high school transcript.
7. Please submit an essay (250-500 words) explaining what career you want to pursue and why. The essay must be written by the applicant without the assistance of others. **Do not include your name in the essay. Please place a cover sheet on top of the essay with your name.**
8. **Please include 2 letters of recommendation.** One letter from a school person and one letter from an outside source (ex: employer, minister, family friend, and neighbor). Please do not use a family relative.
