In the effort to help further the education of local students, the Lone Oak FFA Booster Club is offering a scholarship to graduating seniors. The Lone Oak Agricultural Education Scholarship.

1. The student must be a graduating senior attending Lone Oak High School.
2. They must plan to attend a 4-year university.
3. Must have taken an Ag related class or been a member of the FFA all 4 years of high school
4. Please submit an essay (250-500 words). The essay must be written by the applicant without the assistance of others. **Do not include your name in the essay. Please place a cover sheet on top of the essay with the following information:**
 - A. Name
 - B. Address
 - C. Phone number
 - D. Email address you will have access to after graduation
 - E. Parents Name's
5. Within the essay please include the following topics
 - A. Describe the Ag classes and Ag activities you have taken/been involved in for each year of high school. Include the grades you obtained in the classes taken
 - B. Describe 2 of the most important skills or lessons you learned from your Ag classes/activities
 - C. Describe how the Ag classes/activities will impact your future
 - D. Describe what you plan to study in college
6. **Please include 2 letters of recommendation.** One letter from a school person and one letter from an outside source (ex. Employer, minister, family friend, and neighbor). Please do not use a family relative.
